**LOS ANGELES AREA – Mixed Doubles 40 & Over Supplement – Summer 2023**

All players must follow specific Covid-19 protocols required at each facility. Captains must communicate any special requirements to his/her team members.

Important dates:

- **5/31**      **Initial roster due** (minimum 6 players per team – 3 men & 3 women, which, when paired together do not surpass the team's level)
- 6/5      Schedules published
- 6/12      (or 7 days after schedules published) Last day for captains to request date changes. Both captains must agree to the change or the original published date will stand.
- **7/8**      **Season begins**
- 7/23      Last day for players to request credit or a transfer to another summer team
- 8/10      Last day to add players
- **9/10**      **Season ends**
- 9/22-24      Sectionals – Orange County

Match Format

The Los Angeles Area league match format will be best of 3 sets with a 10 point match tiebreak in lieu of the third set.

Each match shall consist of three lines of Mixed Doubles.

The minimum number of players required for a team must register prior to the Initial Roster Deadline in order to be included in the local league schedule. A minimum team is 3 men and 3 women, each with an NTRP rating that when paired with a partner may not surpass the team's level.

In the combo format, the NTRP difference between members of an individual doubles pair may not exceed 1.0. (For example, a 3.5 and a 4.5 player would be allowed as a pairing on an 8.0 team. A 3.0 player would NOT be allowed to pair with ANY player on an 8.0 team.)

If a self-rated ("S") or computer-rated appealed ("A") player is dynamically disqualified, any matches played at that level will be reversed in all "live" leagues, including Mixed Doubles.

Players must play at least 2 matches to qualify to play at Sectionals. One default will count for a computer ("C") rated player. Self-rated ("S") or computer-rated appealed ("A") must play at least 2 actual matches (a default will not count). **Note:** In order to play at Nationals, a self-rated ("S") or computer-rated appealed ("A") players must play at least 4 matches (defaults will not count) while computer ("C") rated player must play at least 3 matches (1 default will count).

Each player shall have reached forty (40) years of age prior to, or during, the calendar year in which such player plays in his/her first local league match.
