LOS ANGELES AREA – Tri-Level Supplement – Summer 2023

All players must follow specific Covid-19 protocols required at each facility. Captains must communicate any special requirements to his/her team members.

Important Dates:

- **5/25** **Initial roster due** (minimum 6 players per team – at least 2 per level)
- 5/30 Schedules published
- 6/6 (or 7 days after schedules published) Last day for captains to request date changes. Both captains must agree to the change or the original published date will stand.
- **6/25** **Season begins**
- 7/10 Last day for players to request credit or a transfer to another summer team
- 9/7 Last day to add players
- **10/8** **Season ends**
- Dec. 1-3 Sectionals – Orange County
- March 2024 Tri-Level National Invitational for 3.5/4.0/4.5 level Section winners

Match Format

Each match shall consist of three lines of doubles at different NTRP levels. Los Angeles Area will have teams at NTRP levels of 3.0/3.5/4.0 or 3.5/4.0/4.5. **Note:** If there is sufficient interest at the 2.5 and 5.0 levels, we will consider flights to accommodate those levels.

The Los Angeles Area league match format will be the best of 3 sets with a 10-point match tiebreak in lieu of the third set.

The Weekday Tri-Level league is for women only. Provided that there are at least four (4) teams in a Weekday flight, the winner of that flight will advance to Sectionals.

The minimum number of players required for a team must register prior to the Initial Roster Deadline in order to be included in the local league schedule. A minimum team is 6 players, 2 at each NTRP level.

Each match must have at least one player on each line at the proper rating level for that line. His/her partner may be no lower than .5 from that line's rating level. For example, at the 4.0 line, a 4.0 player and a 3.5 player could play together. A player may not play on a line that is under his/her rating level. Teams must have at least 50% of their roster rated at the NTRP level of their team prior to their first match. If a division has only two teams, that minimum is changed to 40%.

If a self-rated ("S") or computer-rated appealed ("A") player is dynamically disqualified, any matches played at that level will be reversed in all "live" leagues, including Mixed Doubles.

Players must play at least 2 matches to qualify to play at Sectionals. One default will count for a computer ("C") rated player. Self-rated ("S") or computer-rated appealed ("A") must play at least 2 actual matches (a default will not count).

The Section Winners at the 3.5/4.0/4.5 level will advance to the National Tri-Level Invitational.

Each player must be eighteen (18) years of age prior to participating in a league match
